

Conant Recess Guidelines:

Listed down below are the recess guidelines that our staff and students will follow at all times. We encourage all students to socially interact with others and to play fair and safely at all times.

1. Students will respect each other at all times during recess.
2. Students will share equipment and take equitable turns using the equipment properly at all times.
3. Students are encouraged to problem solve their own recess issues when possible.
4. Students shall keep their own hands and bodies to themselves at all times.
5. When a student's inappropriate conduct and behavior occurs during recess, staff members will report this issue to the appropriate classroom teacher and if necessary to the principal and vice principal depending on the severity of the inappropriate behavior infraction.
6. Students will clean up after themselves and put away the recess equipment properly after each usage.
7. Students are required to stay within the recess designated area at all times.
8. Any medical issues that arise from recess will be immediately reported to the school nurse.
9. The school nurse and principal will determine whether recess will be indoors or outdoors during that specific day.
10. The physical education classes will have priority over the recess playgrounds during their designated class times.
11. Students are not allowed to engage in non-school members which may include: unauthorized parents, strangers, animals. Instead, students are required to report suspicious behavior immediately to staff members.
12. Classroom teachers may require students who miss classroom and homework assignments, to miss a few minutes of recess to complete their work. This is at the discretion of the classroom teacher and principal and will be kept as minimal as possible.
13. Students who are medically exempt from recess due to medical illness, must provide medical clearance documentation to the school nurse or principal upon full return to recess.
